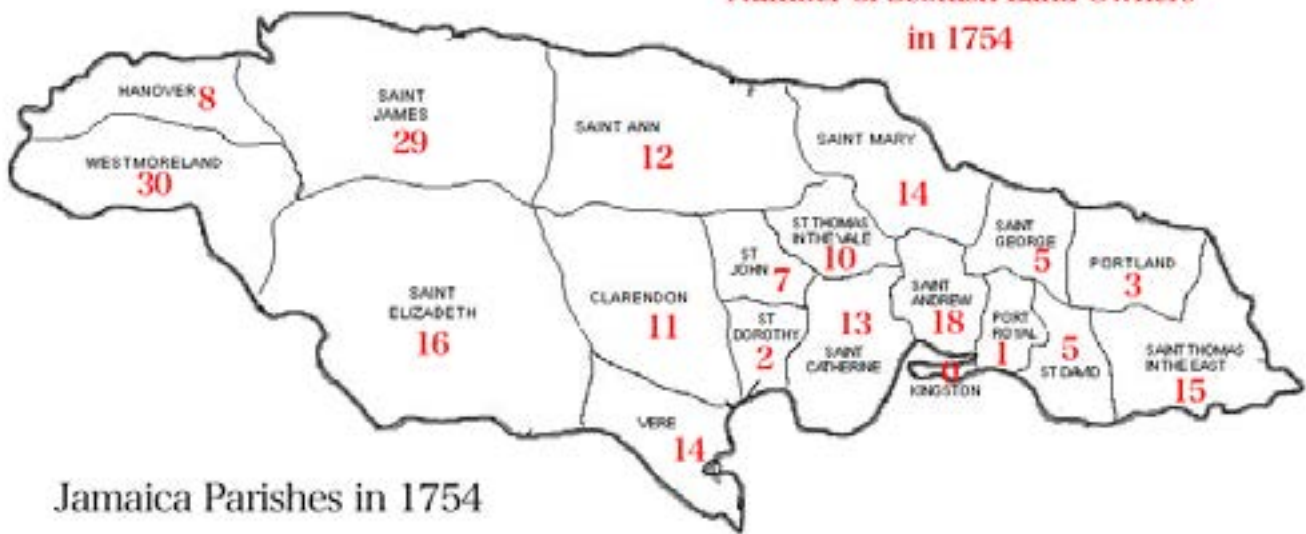

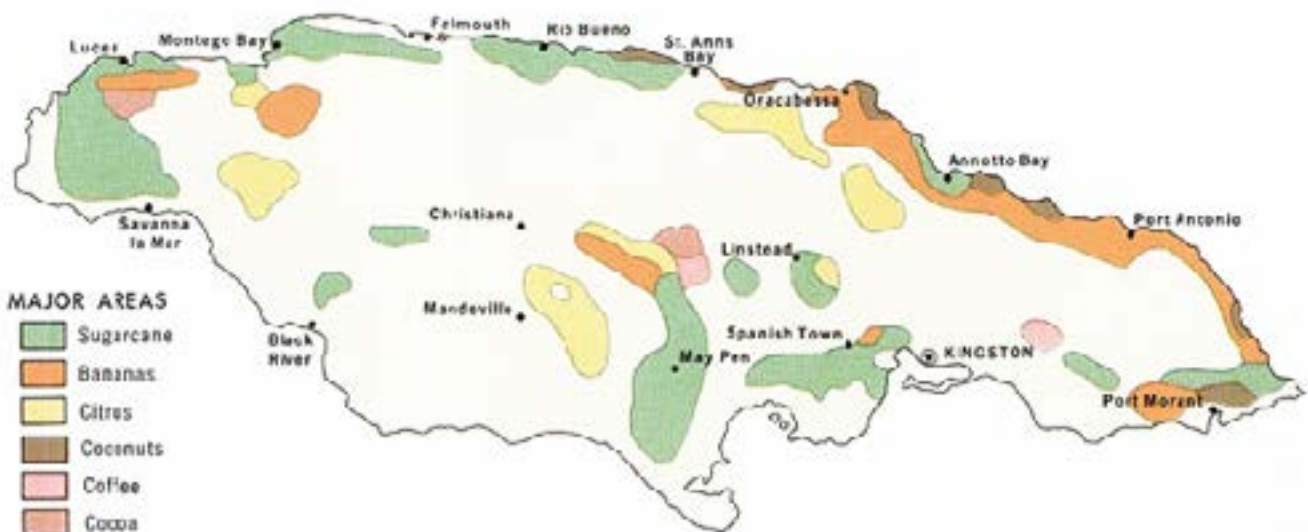
Number of Scottish Land Owners
